2	<p><u>Update on 2020 Budget, Lana Cordes & Heather Shockey</u> Proposed budget reductions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Applied for PayRoll Assistance Loan • Bikes Together Rent – reprieve for April but other months will be postponed for future payment • Reduce Building fund by \$5K – still have \$20K in reserve for emergencies • Office Cleaning – once every two weeks, can consider Board members taking turn on cleaning (not a huge savings....) • Newspaper - \$35K projected loss from reduced advertising, proposed raise for Quincy who delivers the newspaper bundles to businesses and the Block Workers (hasn't received a raise in many years....) • Advertising Grant Program – passed by 12 yes votes (5 no, 3 no response) • Food Pantry – use funds in old restricted fund first before other budget; still receiving donations every single day and will quickly bring in the budgeted \$15K expenses for year; no expenses on weekend food program since children are out of school; teachers did pick up some food and distribute to students; DPS has food programs underway to feed students during the Stay at Home Order/school closures • Board – approval of direction and revisit budget in next quarter for adjustments; Passed by 12 ayes, 0 no, 1 abstain <p>Future Board/Community Meetings If someone wants to present, we can schedule a Zoom Meeting</p> <p>Nam Henderson – Denver Streets Partnership Closing down streets to pedestrians and cyclists only during the Stay at Home Order – one in South Park Hill and one in North Park Hill – with school closures – give people a larger opportunity for getting exercise and fresh air while still</p>
