Have outdoor patio on north side of building (faces neighborhood/residences, not Colfax) Colette Carey – they have been a good neighbor, only big events about once a year. If anyone has questions or concerns about this application, please contact Colette, she lives two blocks away from Fiction and is in contact with neighbors that live adjacent to Fiction. Lisa – if neighbors have strong reaction to this application, we could organize with neighbors and Fiction owners for discussion about potential Good Neighbor Agreement

	East Area Plan – Kevin Wiegand does not support applying density to the blocks adjacent to Colfax where affordable small homes are located and the burden of density is placed upon these existing residents - increasing allowable 5 stories to 8. Collette lives nearby – just density for density's sake – no plans for affordable housing Shane – will increase property taxes and displace existing residents; no guarantee that any affordable housing will be built Lisa – shouldn't be taking a position/sending letter without notification and community outreach Nam – Colfax/Mayfair BID does support the East Area Plan; residents at risk are not supporting the plan; Minneapolis – prior to single family zoning – return to mid-rise multi-family zoning; should reach out to East Colfax in solidarity Maria Flora – should take a position – read through all the comments and they are overwhelming against the plan; plan benefits developers; COVID limited community outreach and many residents are not aware of these plans; National Jewish commented that they have their own plans for their campus as well as Johnson Wales which is private property; concern about losing
