- 4 Denver trash fee proposal Taylor Moellers, Office of Climate Action, Sustainability & Resiliency:
  - Expanded waste services proposal
    - Improve waste service pick-up and include new fees for these new services
    - Residential services currently do not charge for trash and recycling pick-up (paid for by taxes – 'General Fund')
    - Goal of 50% diversion rate from landfill landfill is source of methane gas
    - 96% of customers have recycling service, 20% have compost (started service 10 years ago)
    - Fee based service will not change tax burden by households

Sand Creek Regional Greenway Partnership – Monique Fair, Executive Director:

- Partnership focused on development of trail to fully pave Denver section of trail – looking to continue into Aurora. Enhancement of trail – water fountains, kiosks, shade shelters, art.
