	<p>Long Table Patio, Shane Sutherland</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Most directly affected neighbors, Keith and Jess, do not agree with the compromise proposed by Long Table and the other neighbors stated that they would support Keith and Jess. • Long Table needs a zoning variance to have the patio on the west side, adjacent to the alley – since it would be within the 50 foot distance between the patio and a residential zone district • Chris Cunningham – alley and 29th will have a ‘sound absorbing’ fence, 6 foot height allowed • Shane – subject is tabled until a future meeting • Lana will resend information on the patio location, variance needed, etc. from previous meeting presentation
