3	Salon Joa Liquor License Application, Colfax and Poplar They are located adjacent to Fiction Brewing Want to serve clients and patrons, one drink per client per day. All employees have to sign agreement to check all ID's and make sure they are 21 before they are served. Applying for Beer and Wine license – laws are changing and you are not allowed to serve your clients alcohol without a license, even if you don't charge them for it. Planning on serving One Hope wines, 50% of proceeds go towards different charities. Geneva asked if adjacent property owners have been contacted – have talked to adjacent home owners as well as their clients. Have had residents visit or call in and asking about liquor license. Lyle Hanson lives 1.5 blocks away and does not support their application for a liquor license.
